Stalin increased his power and influence through the expansion of the Soviet Union through Eastern Europe. This was to be done by establishing Communist governments and totalitarian states. Stalin's main objective in his expansion was to invade Poland. This was because if was an unprotected gateway to attack Russia, as done so three times in the past, so if was essential to establish friendly borders. However, if can be argued that Stalin then for more. In June 1945, a coalition government of several parties was set up in Poland. Two years later elections were rigged resulting in a purely Communist government. To preserve communist power the leader of the main opposition party was forced to flee to London. Consequently, Stalin increased Soviet expansion and his communist ideology.

As a result, Polish reforms led to tension increasing between the East and the West due to the belief that Stalin was spreading communism throughout Europe and challenging the balance of power. In Stalin's opinion, it was essential to create this buffer zone of satellite states to maintain the security of Russia Accordingly, Stalin then began to control Hungary. During a time of economic uncertainty, when communism seemed most appealing (as it will share the wealth of society equally), the Communist Party seized control of the Ministry of Interior. This resulted in unquestionable control of the police allowing the arrest of the dominant party leader. Kovacs in 1947, Due to the removal of apposition, the Communists thrived in the government. A one-party state was established to maintain Communist reign too.

The invasion of Hungary, further worsened relationships between the superpowers, because it reaffirmed the thought of Soviet domination. Thus, this created the ideal conditions of an emerging Cold War as it created a clear division in beliefs and forms of power/influence. Due to the Long Telegram, Stalin felt the need to increase the protection of his nation due to America's urge to use its amipotent army. Stalin ensured this by projecting his idealogy on Czechoslovakia Although a communist government had already been established here, the Soviet Union, in 1948, used the army to seize control of the country. Many non-communists were murdered and arrested such as Jan Masaryk. Additionally, rigged elections resulted in sustained power and complete control by Stalin.

Explain two consequences of the Tehran Conference of November 1943

One consequence of the Tehran Conference of November 1943 was that it led to an agreement on opening a second front in France to ultimately defeat the Nazis. Stalin had been insisting on this act for a long time and believed that Roosevett and Churchill were purposely allowing Russia to suffer and then attack them at its weakest. By finally acting openly Stalin's wishes resulted in improved relationships between the Big 3 as for Stalin his country's well-being was considered and ultimately led to the defeat of a common enemy. Hitter and the Nazis.

Another consequence of the Tehran Conference of November 1943 is that it led to increased tension between the Big 3 as either member's opinion was disregarded in certain matters. Churchill's idea of an allied invasion through the Balkans therefore preventing the expansion of the Red Army was rejected by Stalin. This increased tension as it seemed as though the Big 3 was going to become a Big 2. Similarly, there was tension between Churchill and the Soviets when Churchill openly spake about detesting
