Ford, 2017-06-15 Three common routines are seen in almost every primary language arts programs morning messages shared readings and word walls These routines should be integrated to support the total language arts program but are teachers of grades K 2 getting the most bang for their buck out of these activities Morning messages can become very routinized and repeat the same experiences over and over again Shared readings are sometimes
