

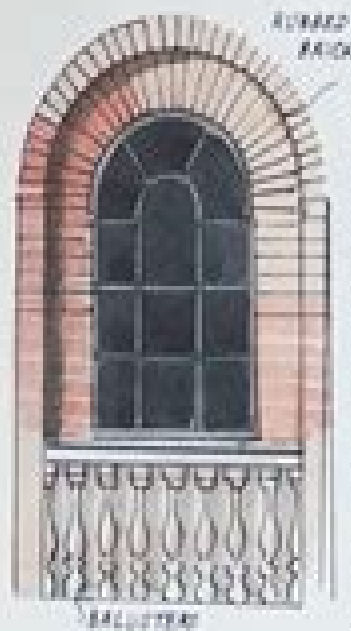

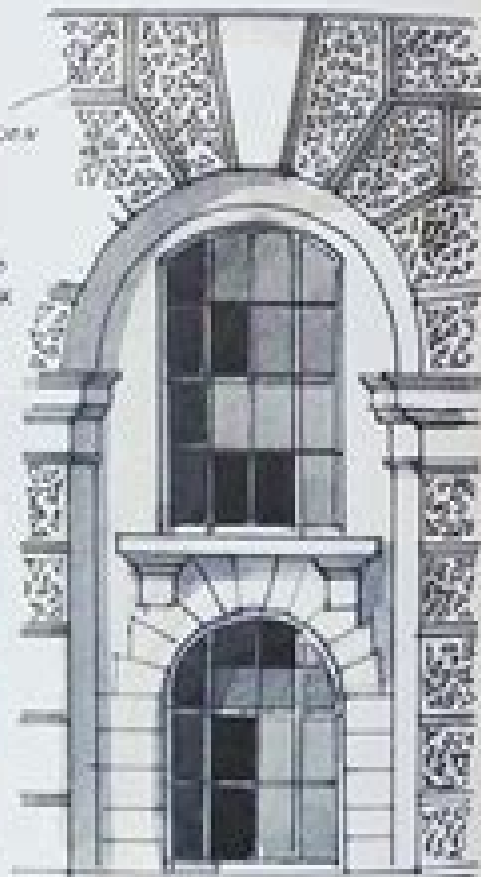

The early window inspired throughout this period. However, it came wearing much later down with Chinese, Turkish or Classical windows, at differing proportions.

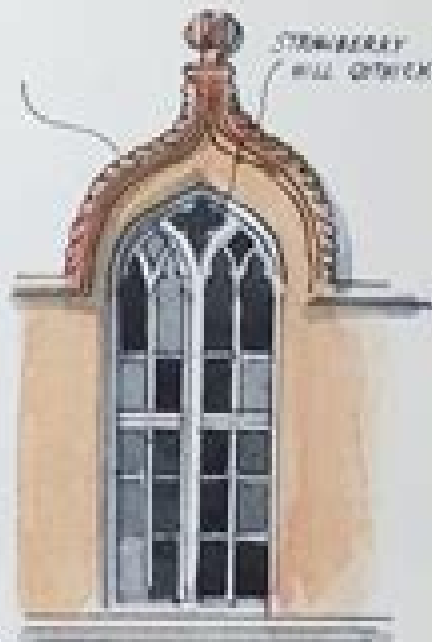
