- Try adding up the first few odd numbers and see if the numbers you get satisfy some sort of pattern. Once you find the pattern, express it as a formula. Give a geometric verification that your formula is correct.
- 3. The consecutive odd numbers 3, 5, and 7 are all primes. Are there infinitely many such "prime triplets"? That is, are there infinitely many prime numbers p such that p + 2 and p + 4 are also primes?
- It is generally believed that infinitely many primes have the form N² + 1, although no one knows for sure.
 - (a) Do you think that there are infinitely many primes of the form N^2-1 ?
 - (b) Do you think that there are infinitely many primes of the form N²−2?
 - (c) How about of the form $N^2 3$? How about $N^2 4$?
 - (d) Which values of a do you think give infinitely many primes of the form N² − α?
- The following two lines indicate another way to derive the formula for the sum of the first n integers by rearranging the terms in the sum. Fill in the details.

$$1 + 2 + 3 + \cdots + n = (1 + n) + (2 + (n - 1)) + (3 + (n - 2)) + \cdots$$

= $(1 + n) + (1 + n) + (1 + n) + \cdots$.

How many copies of n + 1 are in the second line? You may need to consider the cases of odd n and even n separately. If that's not clear, first try writing it out explicitly for n = 6 and n = 7.
