- Need for meaningful dialogue among border agencies within region. It is important for the regulatory agencies (bureau of standards, food and drugs division, Chief Veterinary Officers etc) to discuss ways in improving the trade environment while maintaining their respective mandates (i.e. to protect animal, plant and human health, as per the TBT and SPS agreements). The framework exists in CARICOM (e.g. CVOs do meet regularly, and CROSQ does facilitate the meeting of regional Bureaux of Standards), but the results are not being seen (hence the lack of harmonisation in standards throughout the region).
- Customs must be more trade facilitating than revenue generation
